Be monitored whilst at home with a small piece of equipment that measures your oxygen levels.

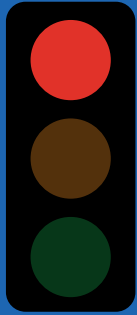

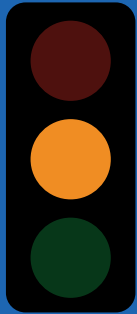

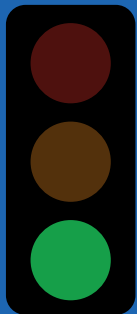
